Spay/Neuter Reminder Call Information for Owners

- Before surgery can be performed all animals must have a rabies vaccine. Owner must bring a current Rabies Certificate unless, the pet is scheduled to be vaccinated the morning of surgery. If the owners do not have proof of vaccination the animal will be vaccinated, and the owner will be charged.
- No food after midnight the evening prior to the surgery. They can have water.
- Please stay in your vehicle at the morning drop off. ORHS staff will come to your vehicle to have you complete and sign the surgery contact form and a transport waiver.
- Please bring your pet to ORHS at **6:45am** for drop off. Please arrive at **6pm** or before for pick up. You will receive post-surgery info and rabies tag at pick up.

- If the vet detects any issues or issues arise during surgery, the vet will attempt to contact you for consent. However, if they can't reach you and they make the decision to proceed you are responsible to pay when you pick up your pet.
- Ferals **MUST BE** in **LIVE TRAP**. We will not transfer or transport if feral is brought in soft or hard shell carrier.
- All services must be planned and in place before the scheduled surgery date. Absolutely no changes or additions will be allowed the morning of surgery.
